

## **Truro Police Department Officer Entrance Examination**

- Examination Date:** October 20, 2018 at 9:00 AM (Must arrive by 8:30AM)
- Examination Location:** Truro Community Center

- Registration Fee:** \$40.00. Please make check or money order payable to Truro Police Department.
- Registration Deadline:** Friday, September 28, 2018 at 4:00 PM
- How to Register:** Applications can be picked up at the Truro Police Department, 344 Route 6, Truro, Massachusetts, or may be downloaded at <https://www.truro-ma.gov/home/pages/jobs>.
- All completed employment applications, along with the registration fee, must be received no later than Friday, September 28, 2018 at 4:00 PM. Further information can be obtained by contacting Lt. Craig Danziger or Sgt. Scott Holway at (508) 487-8730. There is no refund if you do not appear for the examination.
- Examination Check In:** You must arrive by 8:30AM at the testing site. A valid government photo ID is required at check in. No food or drinks are allowed. Absolutely NO electronic devices are allowed (except those medically necessary). You must bring several #2 pencils for the examination. Test results will be sent to the Town of Truro.

### **Basic Qualifications for the Position of Police Officer at Truro Police Department**

Candidates must meet the basic minimum qualifications as determined by the Commonwealth of Massachusetts and Truro Police Department. The minimum qualifications include:

- Be a United States citizen (birth or naturalized);
- Be at least 21 years of age at the time of appointment;
- No felony record (MGL 41-96A);
- Must have and maintain a valid Massachusetts driver's license (by date of appointment);
- Must possess a High School Diploma or have a G.E.D. Certificate;
- Must have and maintain a valid Massachusetts License to Carry Firearms, "LTC" (by date of appointment);
- Must not smoke any tobacco products (MGL 41-101A);
- Must be able to perform the essential functions of a police officer, including being willing and available to perform said functions on weekends, holidays and on an overtime basis or when staffing requires;
- Body art, tattoo(s), intentional scarring, mutilation, or dental ornamentation which is visible while wearing the official uniform is prohibited.
